What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small text file that is downloaded to your computer by websites that you visit or certain emails that you open. Cookies contain specific information that can later be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookies. Cookies are used widely to make websites work better and provide website owners with relevant marketing information.

Why does Novocomms use cookies?

Novocomms uses cookies for technical reasons to enable efficient working of our online service. We typically use both session ID cookies and persistent cookies. Session cookies make it easier for you to navigate our websites, and are deleted when you close your browser. Persistent cookies remain on your hard drive for an extended period and can be used when you return to our websites to help identify you or allow you to log in, or on other third-party sites to communicate to you via online marketing channels. Persistent cookies can be controlled via your browser. If you decide to disable a cookie, you can still visit our websites, but access to some features may be limited.

How can I disable or reset cookies?

You do not need to accept all the cookies used by our websites – you can choose to block some or all of them via your web browser. Please note however that if you remove or block cookies which are strictly necessary for the performance of our websites, they may not function correctly and you may
